## Housing Costs for the week of the NW Christian Convention

A \$25 housing deposit is required when you register or you can pay in full at time of registration.

\*\*Bedding is NOT provided.

Cabins: 1-5; 7-8; 11 \$30 per night (please refer to website for how many people/configuration of these cabins. These cabins do not have a bathroom in them). Each sleeps between 4-8 and has a microwave and minifridge).

Cabins: 6, 9, 10, 12 \$50 per night (these cabins have a toilet and sink and/or a shower. Also comes with microwave and minifridge)

## **RV sites:**

Full hook-up \$30 per night (electric, water and sewer)

\$25 per night (electric and water)

\$15 per night for tents with no water or electric hook-up

**Centennial Lodge:** 16 individual rooms with a men's and women's restroom on each floor. Rooms are single or double occupancy. A few of the rooms can sleep 4 people (refer to website)

\$20 per night single occupancy / \$25 per night double occupancy

Jubilee Lodge Dorms: \$10 per night

Men and women's dorm upstairs in Jubilee Lodge. The dorms are set-up with individual cubicles, each with a bunk bed. Each side of the dorm has restrooms
