THE TABERNACLE REHABILITATION PROJECT opened the doors for some amazing and miraculous transformations in the tabernacle. The new carpet was a labor of love that brought together a diverse group of people who worked tirelessly and showed up to help because they saw a need and filled it. The painting of the tabernacle was another miracle project: layers and layers of paint being scraped off in the blazing summer sun. The workers lifted to the 60foot peak and meticulously scraping, prepping and painting. And then the dream of huge fans to move the air and create a comfortable space even in the heat of summer; and it happened because people gave and people worked. The windows that brought in so much heat were beautifully covered with blinds that are so subtle you almost don't realize they are there but the heat difference is amazing. And because doing it right is so important, the valances at the top of the blinds, were created with onsite original lumber milled in the late 1800's. So much of what was accomplished was done with fervent prayer, volunteer labor, helping hands: love expressing itself in action. And now we need to put a new roof on the tabernacle. It is one more step in the rehabilitation project and it's a big one. Your prayers, your gifts, your care will make it happen. 
